NUMBER ELEVEN IN SCRIPTURE – WARNING, JUDGMENT, CONFUSION, NOTICE, INFO

W.E. Vine Expository Dictionary of New Testament Words: To put in mind, warn, admonish. To teach, make known. State of disorder, disturbance, tumult, anarchy, confounded, put to shame. Things that are not right.

Example: 411, 611, 911 – All are related to finding one's way, getting information, etc.

NUMERICAL FACTS:

- **11** Disciples at the end, one was missing, Judas.
- Matthew 18:**11** – Missing verse 11 in previous versions.
- Matthew 20:6 – In the **eleventh** hour people standing around waiting for someone to hire them.
- Matthew 16:14 – Jesus appeared to the **11** disciples and reproached them for their unbelief and hardness of heart.
- Genesis **11**:9 – Babel. God confused the languages of the people because they had disobeyed Him.
- Leviticus **11**:2 – This is the 101st chapter of the Bible and is filled with warnings.

NUMBER TWELVE IN SCRIPTURE – ORGANIZATIONAL PERFECTION – LAWS, REGULATIONS, RULES, COURTS, JUSTICE

W.E. Vine Expository Dictionary of New Testament Words: *Law* – to divide out, distribute, primarily meant that which is assigned; hence, usage, custom, and then, law, law as prescribed by custom or by statute. *Rule* denotes power, to rule over something – a household, a government, a company, head of the house and so forth; *court* – a place of public meeting where a trial is being held or an uncovered space around a building. *Justice* – denotes what is right, a judicial hearing, acquittal, declared to be right.

- ...related to wisdom, authority and the decision we must make about salvation
- Related to the number 3, $(1 + 2) = 3$
- Exodus 28:21 – 21st verse, number of perfection and salvation $(7 + 7 + 7)$, the 12 sons of Israel
- Exodus 39:14 – 12 stones representing the 12 tribes of Israel
- Luke 12:12 – Wisdom and long understanding
- Revelation 22:2 – Tree of Life; 12 different fruits every month of the year (12 months)
